STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Expenses of the Town of Lincoln Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1947, c. 85, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 85 of the private and special laws of 1947 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 5. County to provide court room, etc. The county commissioners shall provide a suitable place in Lincoln for the holding of the court, and all expenses thereof, including such amount for clerk hire as may be authorized by the county commissioners, shall be paid from the treasury of the county of Penobscot.'
