STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Powers of Fryeburg Village Fire Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1887, c. 176, § 2-A, additional. Chapter 176 of the private and special laws of 1887 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 2-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 2-A. Power to remove snow and regulate parking. Said corporation is hereby invested with power to remove snow from such village streets as deemed proper and necessary; to regulate parking on the village streets by ordinances with reasonable penalties for their violation.'
