STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Western Hancock Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1893, c. 613, § 20, amended. The 1st sentence of section 20 of chapter 613 of the private and special laws of 1893, as amended by chapter 95 of the private and special laws of 1939, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

From and after July +, 1919 the The judge of said court shall receive as compensation an annual salary of \$750 \$1,250, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Hancock together with actual expenses incurred by him in the trial of criminal cases in any town other than that in which said judge may reside; and in addition thereto said judge shall receive for every blank writ signed by him, 5c; for entry of each civil action, 5oc; taxing costs and recording judgment, 25c; writ of execution or possession, 15c.'
