**RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Coffee Pond in the
Town of Casco.**

Outlet of Coffee pond; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$300 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Coffee pond in the town of Casco in the county of Cumberland; provided, however, that said screen shall not be installed at the outlet of Coffee pond until the Sebago 31 Club shall assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further, that the state shall be liable for only $\frac{1}{2}$ the cost of said screen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The screen washed out in 1936 and no other has been erected.
