**AN ACT Relating to the Propagation and Cultivation of Clams, Quahogs
and Mussels.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 61-A, additional. Chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 61-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 61-A. Enforcement of §§ 54-61. It shall be the responsibility of the municipality issuing licenses or grants under authority of sections 54 to 61, inclusive, to enforce all provisions pertaining thereto.'
