# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

# AN ACT Relating to the Breeding and Raising of Mink.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 123-I, additional. Chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 123-I, to read as follows:

#### 'Breeding and Raising Mink

'Sec. 123-I. Breeding and raising mink. Mink that have been propagated in captivity for 2 or more generations shall be considered domesticated animals subject to all the laws of the state with reference to possession, ownership and taxation as are at any time applicable to domesticated animals. Such domesticated mink, the pelts or products thereof, shall be deemed agricultural products and the breeding, raising, producing in captivity and marketing thereof shall be deemed an agricultural pursuit.'
