STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to License Fee for Raising Wild Birds and Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 11, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 6th paragraph of section 11 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'When it appears that such application is made in good faith, and upon the payment of an annual fee of 55 fio, said commissioner may issue to the applicant a breeder's license permitting the breeding and rearing of any species of game birds or wild animals within such enclosure.'
