IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Opening Peabody Pond to Ice Fishing for Big Smelts, Pickerel and Other Fish Except Trout and Salmon.

Peabody pond; opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Peabody pond in the towns of Naples, Sebago and Bridgton, in the county of Cumberland, to ice fishing for big smelts, pickerel and all other fish except trout and salmon during the entire ice fishing season.
