FIFTY-ONE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Failure to Stop Vehicles on Signal of Fish and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 70, amended. Section 70 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

'Any person convicted of a violation under the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of \$100 and costs, which fine and costs shall not be suspended, and an additional penalty of not more than 30 days in jail, at the discretion of the court.'
