**RESOLVE, Regulating the Taking of Clams in the Town of East Machias.**

---

**Taking of clams in East Machias, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue the following rule and regulation:

**'Regulating the taking of clams in East Machias.** It shall be unlawful for any person not a resident of the town of East Machias, Washington county, to dig or take in any manner any clams, quahogs or mussels from the shores and flats on the north side of Machias river beginning at the toll bridge and running easterly along said Machias river and continuing in a northerly direction along the East Machias river.'
