## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge and Recorder of the Yorkshire Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1911, c. 279, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 279 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 30 of the private and special laws of 1935 and by chapter 141 of the private and special laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 15. Salary of judge and recorder. The judge shall receive a salary in full for all services of \$1,500 per annum year to be paid him by the county of York, and the recorder a salary of \$200 \$1,200 per annum year, payable quarterly.'
