STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Men's Dormitory at Gorham State Teachers' College.

Men's dormitory at Gorham state teachers' college; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the current revenues of the general fund of the state the sum of \$275,000, to be expended by the state board of education for constructing and equipping a men's dormitory at the Gorham state teachers' college; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall be carried forward from year to year until such time as the building is constructed and the work completed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

With the increasing male enrolment at the Gorham State Teachers' College, it becomes imperative that more adequate facilities be made available to meet the rooming and living needs of such students.

The college operates the only industrial arts program in the state. The state maintains no housing facilities for male students on the campus. The proposed dormitory would accommodate one hundred men.
