STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Fishing for Black Bass and Pickerel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 33, § 36, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 36 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 'II. There shall be an open season for black bass and pickerel in lakes and ponds from Jun 21st July 1st to September 30th October 15th; in rivers above tide-water from June 21st July 1st to September 15th; in brooks and streams from June 21st July 1st to August 15th. Provided, however, that 3 black bass only may be taken by fly fishing in any one day from June 1st to June 20th and no person shall have in his possession at any one time more than 3 black bass during this period.'
