RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in St. Georges and Little Saint Georges

Lakes in the County of Waldo.

Fishing in St. Georges and Little Saint Georges lakes, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing St. Georges lake and Little Saint Georges lake in the town of Liberty, in the county of Waldo, to ice fishing and establishing a daily limit of 2 salmon or trout per person per day, taken during the open water fishing season.
