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**AN ACT to Amend the Charter of Somerset Academy.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1846, c. 314, amended.** Chapter 314 of the private and special laws of 1846, as amended by chapter 7 of the private and special laws of 1933, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘Said academy is authorized to furnish instruction beyond the studies ordinarily pursued in secondary schools, to charge tuition therefor and to award certificates for proficiency therein.’
