IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Upper Dam Pool, County of Oxford.

Fishing in Upper Dam Pool, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily limit of 4 fish per day per person and the minimum length of trout 8 inches and salmon 14 inches on Upper Dam Pool in the county of Oxford.
