## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the York Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1929, c. 8, § 9, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 9 of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1929 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The trustees to be so elected shall be chosen by a plurality vote of the legal voters within said district, and of rate paying users of water outside said district who are legal voters of the town of York; voting at an election to be specially called and held for the acceptance of this act and the election of trustees on the 1st Monday of August, 1929.'
