STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Judge and the Recorder of the
Northern Aroostook Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1947, c. 38, § 1, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 38 of the private and special laws of 1947 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,500 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1947, c. 38, § 1, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 38 of the private and special laws of 1947 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be ~~\$400~~ \$800 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'
