STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to County Commissioners of Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 6, amended. That part of section 6 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salaries of the county commissioners of Androscoggin county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin, \$1,000, except the chairman of said commission who shall devote each full working day, in addition to his regular duties, which shall be increased by adding to them the superintendence shall superintend of the county buildings, and for all his services his annual salary shall be the sum of \$1,500.'
