STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Designating Beryllium Poisoning as an Occupational Disease.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 26, § 69, amended. Section 69 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 338 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:
- '15. Beryllium poisoning or its 15. Any process involving direct sequelae. exposure to beryllium dust or fume.'
