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**AN ACT Designating Beryllium Poisoning as an Occupational Disease.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 26, § 69, amended.** Section 69 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 338 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

- '15. Beryllium poisoning or its sequelae.      15. Any process involving direct exposure to beryllium dust or fume.'
