SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 684,
L. D. 414, Bill "An Act Relating to
Combination Highway and Railroad Bridge
Across Fore River."

Amend said Amendment by striking out the 2nd paragraph thereof
and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

" Referendum. The aldermen of cities, the selectmen of towns
and the assessors of the several plantations of this state are
hereby empowered and directed to notify the inhabitants of their
respective cities, towns and plantations to meet in the manner
prescribed by law for calling and holding biennial meetings of
said inhabitants for the election of senators and representatives,
at a special state-wide election to be held on September 10, 1951
to give in their votes upon the acceptance or rejection of the fore-
going act, and the question shall be:"
