STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating fishing in Horne Pond in the town of Limington, in the County of York.

Fishing in Horne Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Horne pond in Limington in the county of York to the taking of smelts with hook and line.
