**RESOLVE, Regulating fishing in Horne Pond in the town of Limington,  
in the County of York.**

**Fishing in Horne Pond, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner  
of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to  
issue a rule and regulation opening Horne pond in Limington in the county  
of York to the taking of smelts with hook and line.
