RESOLVE, Regulating fishing on Sebago Lake in the County of Cumberland.

Fishing on Sebago Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Sebago lake in the county of Cumberland to fishing through the ice for cusk with not more than 5 set lines per person, which lines shall have a sinker thereon of not less than 4 ounces in weight which shall be not more than 24 inches from the end of the line to which the hook is attached, said sinker being placed on the bottom of the lake when in use. Further providing that lines set for cusk within the provisions of this resolve need not be under the immediate supervision of any person but must be tended every 12 hours.
