#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Transportation of Deer Skins Beyond Limits of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 87, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 87 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person shall sell or give away any deer or part thereof or deer skin to be transported or carried beyond the limits of this state nor shall any person buy or accept as a gift any deer or part thereof or deer skin for its transportation; nor shall any resident of this state at any time carry or transport in any manner or attempt to carry or transport in any manner beyond the limits of this state any deer or part thereof or deer skin; provided, however, that any resident of this state may purchase a license which will entitle him to transport or cause to be transported a deer legally killed by him within this state to a place beyond the limits of this state, and the fee for this license shall be \$20.25; provided further, that any resident of this state may procure a permit from the commissioner which will entitle him to transport or cause to be transported a deer skin from a deer legally killed by him within this state to a place beyond the limits of this state.'
