IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing on Rangeley Stream in the County of Franklin.

Fishing on Rangeley stream, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing red posts on opposite shores of Rangeley stream indicating the point on Rangeley stream where Rangeley lake begins and Rangeley stream ends.
