STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to East Limington Improvement Society.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Directors and trustees of East Limington Improvement Society; vacancies filled. Melville A. Small of Limington in the county of York and state of Maine, is hereby empowered and authorized to fill by written appointment, until their respective successors in office are elected and qualified, the vacancies existing in the offices of directors and trustees of East Limington Improvement Society, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of Maine, which are now revised statutes of 1944, chapter 50.
