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**AN ACT Relating to Eastern Maine Orphans' Home.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Directors and officers of Eastern Maine Orphans' Home.** Edward F. Ward, Edward P. Murray, Thomas Birmingham and Norbert Dowd, all of Bangor, in the county of Penobscot and state of Maine and Thomas M. Nelligan of Orono in said county and state are hereby constituted the directors and trustees until the next annual meeting or their successors are elected and qualified, of Eastern Maine Orphans' Home, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of Maine which are now revised statutes 1944, chapter 50, to fill the vacancies in the offices of directors and trustees of the said corporation caused by the deaths of all incumbents thereof and to wage and conduct the affairs and business of the said corporation in accordance with the charter of the said corporation and the provisions of law.
