STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Charter of the City of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1931, c. 54, Art. II, § 2, amended. The last paragraph of section 2 of article II of chapter 54 of the private and special laws of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Members of the city council shall serve without compensation receive the sum of \$400 per year in full for compensation, same payable quarterly.'

Referendum; effective date; return to secretary of state. This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of the legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the city of Bangor at the next regular city election called and held for the purpose at the regular voting places of the city by the officers of the city of Bangor authorized to call such election. A check list shall be used at such election. The city clerk shall prepare the required ballots, on which he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall the Act Relating to the Charter of the City of Bangor," passed by the 95th legislature, be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. The result shall be declared by the municipal officers and due certificate thereof filed by the city clerk with the secretary of state.

This act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at said election.
