STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Stipend to Agricultural Societies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 27, § 16, amended. The 6th sentence of section 16 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'No society shall receive any portion of the stipend in excess of \$10,000, except that such limitation shall not apply to any additional stipend provided for by the provisions of section 15 of chapter 77 and section 13 of chapter 77-A.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 77-A, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 77-A of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 289 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'A sum equal to $\frac{1}{2}\%$ of such total commissions shall be paid to the treasurer of state to be credited to the "stipend" fund provided by section 16 of chapter 27.'
