**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Lincoln Plantation, County of Oxford.**

---

**Fishing in Lincoln plantation, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing the tributaries to Magalloway river from Azischohos dam to the New Hampshire line, namely; Meadow brook, Bennett brook, Town Hall brook and Clark brook in Lincoln plantation, county of Oxford.
