HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 791, L. D. 471, Bill "An Act Relating  
to Automobile Travel by State Employees".

Amend said bill by striking out all after the underlined  
word "miles" in the 11th line thereof and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

' 1 provided, however, that the state shall pay inspectors of seed  
potatoes 7¢ per every mile so travelled. -- Provided further, that  
the rate may be set by the travel supervisor at not exceeding  
10¢ per mile on any one trip when more than 1 passenger from one  
or more departments are assigned by the travel supervisor and that  
the charges for such mileage shall be apportioned by the travel  
supervisor to the various departments involved. '
