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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Certain Towns in York and Oxford Counties for  
Snow Removal.**

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**Certain towns; amounts for snow removal charged off. Resolved:**  
That the state highway commission be, and hereby is, authorized to charge off the sums listed below, charged to the several towns for snow removal for the season 1947-1948:

Brownfield	\$5,548.66
Waterboro	4,166.48
Newfield	1,692.55
Dayton	1,207.09
Lyman	1,171.53

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

It was the understanding that the state would pay for all snow removal cost. However, the state billed for towns' share. These towns had heavy losses during forest fires.
