STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Classroom and Library Building at Farmington State Teachers' College.

Classroom and library building at Farmington state teachers' college. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the current revenues of the general fund of the state the sum of \$520,000 to be expended by the state board of education for constructing and equipping a classroom and library building at the Farmington state teachers' college, and for converting and renovating the present library space.

This appropriation shall not lapse but shall be carried forward from year to year until such time as the building is constructed and the work completed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The college has an insufficient number of classrooms. More space must be created.

The present library facilities of the Farmington State Teachers' College are inadequate to serve the needs of such a program. More room is needed to accommodate the student enrolment and the increased number of volumes made possible by the perpetual income from a recent bequest of \$50,000.
