IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to the State Liquor Stock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 11, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 11 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 92 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘The commission is authorized to keep and have on hand a stock of wines and spirits for sale, the value of which, computed on less carload price quotations f. o. b. warehouse filed by liquor and wine vendors, shall not at any time exceed, by more than \$1,000,000, the amount of the working capital authorized.’
