**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Wing at State Police Building, in
Augusta.**

State police building; appropriation for addition to. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$35,000 for construction of an additional wing to headquarters building of state police, in Augusta. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state police building is crowded and there is need of more space to efficiently perform the functions of the state police.
