STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of the Members of the Industrial Accident Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, § 29, amended. The 1st sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 29 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 144 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The chairman shall receive a salary of \$6,000 \$7,000 per year, and the other commissioners a salary of \$5,500 \$6,500 each per year.'
