**AN ACT Relating to State Aid to Towns Maintaining Evening Schools.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 166, amended.** Section 166 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 166. State aid to towns maintaining evening schools.** Whenever the superintending school committee of any town shall have maintained during the school year an evening school as provided by section 32, said town shall be reimbursed by the state a sum equal to  $\frac{2}{3}$   $\frac{1}{2}$  the amount paid for instruction in such evening school. Such schools shall meet the approval of the commissioner in regard to the qualifications of instructors, length of term, class attendance and subjects offered.'
