STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Conditional Sales Agreements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 106, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 106 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Such agreement as provided in the preceding paragraph shall be binding upon a husband only when signed by him, and regardless of whether such agreement relates to the necessities of life, or otherwise. Any person who permits a wife to sign her husband's name to any such agreement, when such person is acting as the other party thereto, or as his agent, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'
