STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Membership of Maine Development Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 35, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 35 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 156 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Maine development commission; how constituted. The Maine development commission, as heretofore established, shall consist of ## 12 members. Said commission shall be constituted as follows: the governor, the commissioner of agriculture, the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries, the forest commissioner, and 7 other citizens of the state to be appointed by the governor and confirmed by the council. Said official members shall hold office during their respective terms. The other appointments shall be for a term of 3 years.

The commission shall choose one of its members to act as chairman.'
