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**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for State Military Defense Commission.**

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**State military defense commission; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, and the sum of \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953, from the general fund to the state military defense commission for cooperation with the federal government for program in and construction of armories and training facilities for the reserve components, including the national guard.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Under federal law, provisions have been made by the Brooks bill, so called, to construct armories and training facilities on a basis of 75% federal and 25% state. The purpose of this resolve is to meet the state's share in the program.
