STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Clyde H. Getchell, of Augusta.

Clyde H. Getchell; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$9,595 from the general fund of the state, to be paid to Clyde H. Getchell, of Augusta, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for loss of income from his store and cabins due to a detour around his property because of road construction from May, 1950 until the middle of October, 1950.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The detour around Mr. Getchell's property and business resulted in a loss of income from the store and cabins from a figure of \$46,116.17 in 1949 to a figure of \$36,519.24 in 1950, or a loss of \$9,595.
