## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

# AN ACT Prohibiting Sunday Stock Car Racing, Horse Pulling and Harness Racing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 121, § 40, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 40 of chapter 121 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'In any city or town that shall so vote, as hereinafter provided, it shall be lawful to engage in as a participant, manager or official, or to attend as a spectator any outdoor recreational or competitive amateur sport or game, except boxing, horse racing, harness horse racing, horse pulling, stock car racing, air circuses or wrestling between the hours of I P. M. and 7 P. M. on Sunday.'
