STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Certain County Officers in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 6, amended. That part of section 6 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salaries of the county commissioners of Washington county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Washington, \$1,000 \$1,300,'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 130, amended. That part of section 130 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the county attorney of Washington county, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Washington, \$1,500 \$1,800,'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 79, § 146, amended. That part of section 146 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the county treasurer of Washington county, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Washington, \$1,200 \$1,300,'

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 79, § 165, amended. That part of section 165 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the sheriff of Washington county, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Washington, \$2,500 \$3,000,'

Sec. 5. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the register of deeds of Washington county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Washington, \$1,650 \$1,950,'

Sec. 6. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to clerk hire in county offices in Washington county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Washington county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$1,800 \$2,730; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$1,200 \$1,500; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$1,200 \$1,500; for expenses of clerk of courts and his subordinates while attending sessions of the superior court at Calais, such sums as may be allowed by the court.'

Sec. 7. R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to salary of the judge of probate in Washington county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Washington, \$1,500 \$1,800,'

Sec. 8. R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the register of probate in Washington county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Washington, \$1,500 \$1,800,'
