STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Authorizing Cities and Towns to Collect Garbage and Rubbish
and Make Service Charge Therefor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 80, § 83, sub-§ XXI, additional. Section 83 of chapter 80 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new subsection, to be numbered XXI, to read as follows:

‘XXI. For collecting and disposing of garbage and rubbish and for making a service charge therefor from time to time upon improved lots of land, with buildings thereon, from which said garbage or rubbish is taken and against the owner thereof, or person in possession, and said service charge shall be no more than the proportionate expense to said city or town of such collection and disposal and shall be applied thereto.’
