STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Permits to Hunt and Fish for Members of the Armed Services of the United States.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 32, sub-§ XI, additional. Section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection, to be numbered XI, to read as follows:
 - 'XI. A permit to hunt and fish shall be issued at the resident license fee to any member of the armed forces of the United States of America who is a citizen of the United States and has been stationed at some military post or station within the state for the period of 3 months next prior to application for such permit. Said permits shall be in force only during the time the holder thereof is stationed at a military post or station within the state.

Permits shall be issued by the clerk of the town in which said military post or station is situated.

Holders of such permits shall be subject to all the laws of the state and the rules and regulations of the commissioner regulating hunting and fishing; and for violations of said laws or rules and regulations, such permit shall be revoked in the same manner as provided in this chapter for the revocation of hunting and fishing licenses.'
