STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of State Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 57, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 5. Salaries and expenses of members. The salary of the chairman of the commission shall be \$6,000 \$7,000 per year and the salary of each of the other members shall be \$4,000 \$5,000 per year, and in addition each member shall be allowed his reasonable expense incurred in the performance of his duties; provided, however, that such expense shall not include travel between his place of residence and the commission office, or board and lodging in the city or town where such office is located.'
