SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 263, L. D. 551, Bill "An Act Providing for General-Purpose Educational Aid to Cities, Towns, Plantations and Community School Districts."

Amend said Bill by striking out the 2nd paragraph from the end of that part designated "Sec. 201" thereof and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'It is the intent of the legislature that the formula contained in this section shall serve as a guide for the allocation of such appropriations as may be made by successive legislatures with respect to this school subsidy payment, and it is not the intent of the legislature to guarantee to the several cities and towns any more or any less than the sum total so appropriated.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined words "inadequate or", which precede the last word of the 8th paragraph thereof.
