SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1036, L. D. 564, Bill "An Act
Relating to Number of Voting Districts."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last paragraph thereof and
inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

" 'The municipal officers, 60 days before any election, may,
after public notice and hearing, divide towns and wards of cities
into not more than 3 5 convenient voting districts.'"
